Chico, Calif. – The City of Chico will be holding a workshop to continue its discussion with the community about the Chico 2030 General Plan Update. The purpose of the workshop is to discuss a wide variety of issues that will affect Chico into the future. Workshop participants will have the opportunity to provide feedback on policy issues related to the environment, economic development, and mixed-use and infill development in Chico.

“Chicoans’ participation in the General Plan update process is critical in creating a document that is relevant and represents our collective vision for our city,” said Steve Peterson, Planning Services Director. Peterson added, “We need to hear from the community to ensure that there is a proper balance of environmental, social and economic considerations for the long term health of the City.”
